5. Regional Reports

Seb Walker gave a presentation on current British Rowing policies and initiatives. Day tickets have been introduced. There have been changes to the BR Insurers and clubs should be aware of how this affect them. Senior Championships have been re-introduced and will require support from volunteers.

Regional membership has largely recovered form the pandemic though it has not grown significantly. Competitions in the region have had varying success and the region may look to catalyse support for those that need them.

There have been a significant increase in cancellations of competitions. The region may want to consider whether it can offer a plan B especially for the tideway heads.

Seb highlighted the extensive successes of clubs form the region.

Regional Plan – looking to expand the hub concept for youth rowing.

Helen Middleton is looking to establish one of the BR coastal sculling centre and beach sprints in the region. We already have a centre in the south of the region at Mersea Island. We ran a session at Gorleston for youngsters. There will be a GB pathway session on the coast in Norwich, probably in February. Details to follow.

At the Los Angeles Olympics, lightweight rowing is out and beach sprints are out.

The region held a successful coaching café Look to hold another in the new year.

The region has opportunities for volunteers to get involved on a wider platform than their club. These are opportunities for all ages of volunteers.

Membership numbers are looking good. Survey take-up was good. 40% said Community Membership with add-ons was the way forward but 29% were happy as they are. Not a conclusive result.



Community membership and day tickets already added this year so not going to rush into new initiatives without consideration.

Club affiliation – this year will stay as base fee plus members. There will be add-ons such as club affiliation plus insurance – still to be developed in detail. FAQs being developed. Likely to be much cheaper than existing club insurance – likely to be \pounds 300-400 (!),

Also adding "racing names" product, for social groups who wish to alumni groups who are not associated with an existing entity.

There will be an inflationary increase in general membership fees.

Looking to create a tiered membership model e.g. small, medium, large, To have an amnesty period for clubs to declare their true membership.

Club census in May – 80% clubs wanted BR to be in touch with key topics being coaches and equipment.
