

Where the membership and affiliation fees go (£1.6 million)




The Challenges – a personal view

- We are a mid-size sport and currently have little headroom scope to invest
- Climate change is increasingly impacting the sport
- Technology ClubHub, no app, poor tech implementation
- Headquarters that is from a previous era
- Poor connectivity between Hammersmith, regions, clubs and competitions
- Limited capacity to deliver


The positives – a personal view

- Significant improvements over the last four years in culture and operational effectiveness
- Although governance sounds dry, getting it right will enable better alignment of the needs of clubs and competitions
- BR staff looking at commercialisation ideas for both the NGB and for clubs
- Open to regions to bid for investment if they can show a return on the investment


New Board Committees




Connecting with the community - We have two structures that overlap...
